“We chose Forest Hills of DC because our community is located in the Forest Hills section of the District and because it is a natural fit with our Forest Side location. In addition, the organization provides short-term, post-hospitalization, sub-acute rehabilitation and long-term care in a licensed skilled nursing facility.
